GOLF

It is a pleasure to welcome you to our club, and we trust you will have a memorable experience at The Royal Mayfair. In order to ensure that you have an enjoyable experience while at the Mayfair, please familiarize yourself with some of the clubs' guidelines and traditions.

ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, the member hosting you will register you in the Golf Shop. Please make yourself comfortable by using our practice facilities and locker room amenities.

DRESS CODE

Proper attire is required at all times while on Club property.

Gentleman

Appropriate golf attire for men includes slacks or tailored shorts, collared shirts, turtle necks or mock turtle necks. **All shirts must be tucked in while on the golf course and practice areas.** Rainwear, jackets, hats and other clothing to deal with the elements are also acceptable. Hats must be worn in the forward position.

Ladies

Appropriate golf attire for females includes dresses, slacks, skirts or tailored shorts. Midriffs are not to be exposed. Collared shirts, blouses, turtle necks or mock turtle necks; as well as rainwear, jackets, hats, and other clothing to deal with the elements are also acceptable.

CELLULAR PHONES

The use of cellular telephones are strictly prohibited, except in the case of a medical emergency. To preserve the integrity of the club, and out of respect for members and their guests, we ask that you please abide by the club's policy. Cellular phones may be used discreetly for **non-verbal** communication. Cellular phones may be used in phone booths, located outside the Spike Bar in the main hallway of the Clubhouse or in the Parking Lot.

PACE OF PLAY

Royal Mayfair's standard is that all rounds must be played in 4 hours or less. This policy is strictly enforced by the club.

COURSE CONDITIONS

The Club takes pride in presenting a well-conditioned championship golf course on a day to day basis. Please assist us in maintaining the conditioning by following the few practices below:

Divots: Replace all divots, if the divot is not replaceable please use the sand and seed bottles provided to fill the divot. Do not use the sand and seed mix to fix divots on tee boxes, our grounds crew takes care of that on a daily basis.

Ball Marks: The Club provides complimentary divot tools, we appreciate you fixing all ball marks.

Bunkers: Please fully rake and smooth bunker after use. Rakes are to be left outside the bunker.
